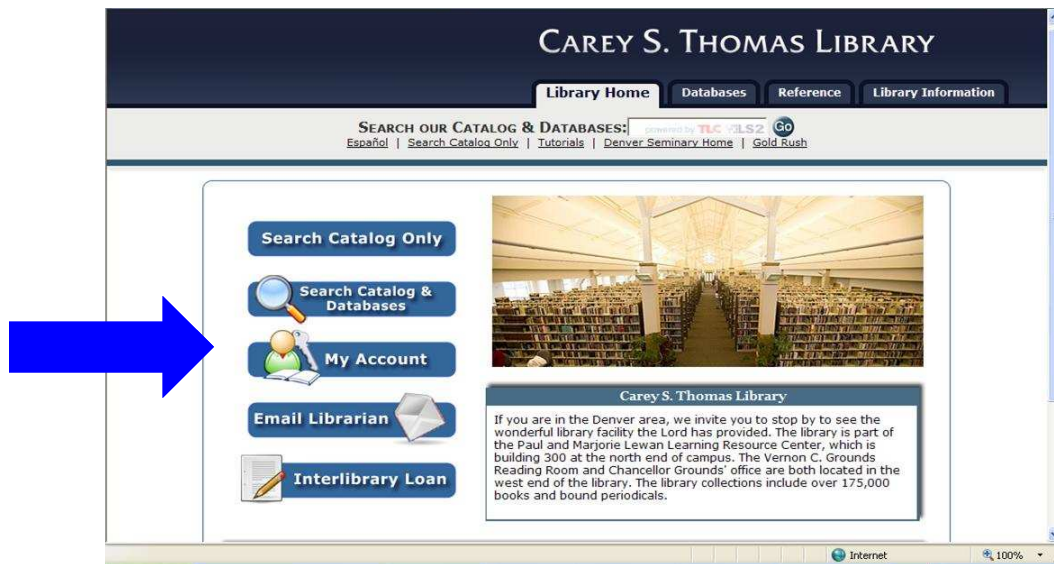


Accessing Your Library Account

Your library ID is the entire barcode on the back of your student ID and your PIN, (if you opened your account prior to 2011, the PIN is probably your phone number without the area code and without the dash. It is also simple to set up your own EZ Logon at this screen—and we highly suggest this.. Once logged into your account, among several available options, you can check the status of any items you have out, and renew them (if they are not on hold for another patron or have already been renewed previously.)
